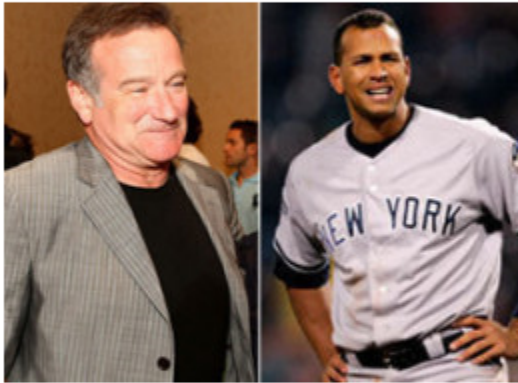

The Rushmore building on the Upper West Side got a heaping spoonful of star power this week.

First it [was reported](#) that actor Robin Williams was renting a place for \$15,000 a month, and now, Yankees slugger [Alex Rodriguez is buying](#) a penthouse in the building.

The 3,600 square-foot [bachelor pad](#), with sprawling living and dining room spaces and working fireplaces, is [estimated](#) to cost around \$6.5 million.
